PRINCIPLE CENTERED PARENTING

CREATIVE COOPERATION = SYNERGY

- Synergy is the essence of <u>principled centered</u> <u>parenting</u>: the <u>whole</u> is greater than the sum of its parts.
- Synergy unleashes the greatest potential of each member of the family.
- UNITY in the family with it's DIVERSITY of persons (opinions, personalities, quirks, etc.) is the greatest proof of unconditional love.

DEPENDENT: We are directed, nurtured and sustained by others.

INDEPENDENT: We take care of ourselves, becoming inner-directed and self-reliant. "Independence is an achievement".



INTERDEPENDENT: As we continue to grow, we discover that all of nature is interdependent, that the higher reaches of our nature have to do with our relationships with others. "Interdependence is a choice".

PRINCIPLE CENTERED PARENTING

"Character-based" approach to personal and interpersonal growth: children need parents to provide structure, set boundaries, and laydown guardrails that are enforced, in order to improve and be well adjusted in the world.

Cooperation does not mean "permissiveness". Some parents think it is virtuous to let children decide everything, but it can be harmful.

DOMESTIC WELL-BEING IS A FUNDAMENTAL HUMAN NEED

Home is not just a building or a shelter, but a vehicle for carrying emotions, memories, and culture. Home is the focus of our most important relationships and most private moments.

The home provides an environment where people develop and mature humanly and spiritually. The emotions surrounding home provide for the most formative experiences of our lives.


The home gives tacit knowledge: it teaches through the material order and beauty of its walls, floors, bedrooms, and table settings.

- Contribute and cooperate with the care of the home




SERVICE TO OTHERS

#5 - RECOGNITION




- <u>Celebrate</u> achievements

- Love can't be measured, it always exaggerates




A strong intergenerational family is potentially one of the most fruitful, rewarding, and satisfying interdependent relationships.
